FEBRUARY 2010

14th - Santa Clara River Estuary, Ventura, 2-4 pm

MARCH 2010

6th - J Street Drain & Ormond Beach, Oxnard, CA 2-4 pm

Wetlands Clean up & Storm Drain Clean Up that discharges into the Ormond Beach Wetlands. This is also a pre-nesting season beach-cleanup to protect nesting birds from ingesting trash!

APRIL 2010

25th - Santa Clara River Estuary, Ventura, 1-3 pm

Help protect and restore the ecological integrity and water quality of the Santa Clara River Estuary, which serves as a vital nursery for wildlife and endangered species such as the Southern California Steelhead. Thousands upon thousands of pieces of trash line the banks and riparian habitat of this ecological treasure. A ceremonial opening to bless the Estuary and our efforts will be conducted by Mati Waiya, Chumash Ceremonial Elder and Wishtoyo's Executive Director.

(Meet and Park on the North Side of the Harbor Blvd Bridge over the Santa Clara River Estuary- exit highway 101 at Victoria Boulevard, head west towards the beach; R on Olivas; L on Harbor blvd for roughly .4 miles, and park before the bridge on the right hand side of Harbor blvd).

MAY 2010

22nd - J Street Drain & Ormond Beach, Oxnard, CA 2-4 pm

Pick up trash from J. St. and out of the J. St. Drain storm channel that discharges into the Ormond Beach Wetlands. This event will be conducted in English & Spanish, with Jorge Napoles of LULAC.

SEPTEMBER 2010

18th (Coastal Clean Up Day!) – San Buenaventura State Beach, 9-11 am

This beach features swimming, surfing and picnicking. The beach has two miles of sandy beach. Bike trails connect other nearby beaches. The beach is the site for a number of special events, such as the Pirate Festival, triathlon, and volleyball tournaments. A 1,700-foot pier has a snack bar, restaurant and bait shop.
