27th – Santa Paula Creek, 3:30-6 pm (After School [COASTWEEKS](#) Clean Up!)

Santa Paula Creek is littered with trash ranging from plastic bags to shopping carts. The trash and debris from the Santa Paula Creek, a major tributary to the Santa Clara River, not only impairs Southern California Steelhead habitat and the aesthetic integrity of the creek, but impairs the ecological integrity and water quality of Ventura County's coastal and marine waters.

(Directions: From the 101 freeway head East on the 126, Pass through Santa Paula over the Santa Paula Creek bridge, Make a left on Hallock Drive, make a left onto Telegraph Road and meet along the Santa Paula Creek bridge on Telegraph Road; (For Google directions: 17350 E. Telegraph Rd, Santa Paula, Ventura, CA).

27th – Ormond Beach Wetlands & J.St. Drain, 3:30-6 pm (After School [COASTWEEKS](#) Clean Up!)

The Ormond Beach Wetlands is home to, and serves as migratory grounds for, numerous federally listed endangered species including the snowy plover, California least tern, and tidewater goby. The wetlands are of significant aesthetic, recreational, and spiritual importance to Oxnard's residents. The trash that enters J-Street Drain impairs the water quality of the Ormond Beach Wetlands and Oxnard's Beaches, harming the health of humans, fish, and birds. Furthermore, trash lining the J-Street drain and the vegetation along J-Street drain impairs the well being and health of local residents, decreases property value, and drives away tourists. This trash pick up event starting at and in J St. Drain and making its way to Ormond Beach, not only will improve the water quality of our coastal waters and the habitat for endangered, resident, and migratory species, but it will provide all Oxnard community members and residents with a pristine Ormond Beach Wetlands to enjoy.
